Frequently Asked Questions**

**What financial aid applications are required for transfer students and when are they due?**

Please review the chart below to find out what applications are required for financial aid consideration and their respective due dates. Each published deadline means the application has to be **received by** Providence College by the date listed. Therefore, be sure to submit all relevant application(s) to the agencies that are processing them for you in enough time for Providence College to receive them by the required due date. These applications are due to the Office of Financial Aid regardless of a student’s application status with the Office of Admissions.

**What are your school codes for these applications?**

To ensure that your application reaches Providence College you must indicate our school code of **3693** on the CSS Profile application. Please note that this form is required in addition to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Our school code for the FAFSA is **003406**.

**When will I know my Admission decision?**

Please review the chart below to find out when the deadlines are for Admission materials and approximate decision notification timelines. Even though a student may not know what their admissions decision may be, the financial aid applications still need to be submitted by the published deadlines stated above.

<b>Spring Transfer</b>	December 1	Mid to Late December

**When will I know my award?**

Transfer applicants can expect a tentative Financial Aid Notice approximately 2-3 weeks after they are notified of their admissions decision if all financial aid materials have been received and are complete.

**Once admitted, will I be required to provide any additional information to the Office of Financial Aid?**

Yes! If you have been admitted and received a tentative financial aid offer, you will be required to provide a copy of final Federal Income Tax Returns, including all schedules and W2 forms for both parent and student (if applicable) in order to finalize the award. You may also be required to complete a Verification Worksheet if selected for verification by the U. S. Department of Education. Selection for this process is random and is based on the information you provide on your FAFSA. You will be notified under separate cover of these requirements.

**What types of need-based aid are available for transfer?**

Transfer students who demonstrate financial need will always be evaluated for all federal grants, loans, and work programs. Funding is limited and institutional need-based aid is determined on a funds available basis.

**Are merit scholarships available to transfer students?**

No. The Office of Admission does not offer any merit scholarship opportunities to transfer students.
