Study Abroad Fee

Students participating on Fall/Spring or Full Year study abroad programs are assessed a one-time study abroad fee of \$1000, regardless of the type of program they enroll in (i.e., direct enrollment or via program provider).

With this fee, students

- Maintain their status as full-time enrolled students at Providence College
- Retain course registration priority, as established for their Class Year
- Retain housing priority status, for those in residence on campus
- Access, while abroad, to CyberFriar, Angel, HELIN Library Catalog and Subject Databases, as well as their PC email account
- Access, while abroad, to their academic advisor and to the services of the Office of the Dean of Undergraduate Studies and the Center for International Studies
- Faculty evaluation and approval of courses taken abroad and the processing of academic credit earned abroad by the Center for International Studies for posting on their PC transcript by the Office of Enrollment Services
- Academic oversight of programs and periodic on-site evaluation visits by the Center for International Studies and the faculty
