

Karen Schroeder wins the Howard Eves Award for Meritorious Service to the Section

The Howard Eves Award for Meritorious Service is given by the Northeastern Section every five years to an individual for outstanding service to the Section. It is named after the co-founder and first Chairperson of the Section, Howard Eves of the University of Maine. Karen J. Schroeder of Bentley College has been selected as the fourth recipient of this award. It will be presented to Karen at the Fall 2005 meeting, the fiftieth anniversary of the Section.

Karen has served the NES in many capacities. She was Chair of the Section from 1989 to 1991 and Governor from 1994 to 1997. In 1987 she was in charge of local arrangements for the Fall Meeting, which was one of the best attended meetings of the Section. She was instrumental in the establishment of both the Section's Dinner Meetings and Minicourses and served on the committee to revise the Section bylaws as well as the committee that drew up the guidelines for the Howard Eves Award. She served the Section as Student Chapters Coordinator, as well as being a member of the national MAA Committee for Student Chapters.
